BE WATCHFUL

Being watchful is something that is throughout Scripture either directly stated or implied. It is inclusive of various versions in the Word of God but saying the same. Watchfulness is extremely important as we give ourselves over to being watchful we are able to see hidden dangers and avoid them, which those who are not watchful cannot see and stumble into the sorrows that await them. These sorrows are extremely heavy.

Evil is always present in our fleshly nature and the heart of this nature. In addition evil is present in spiritual darkness which is by Satan and his evil spirits. With this being said, deceit is ever present waiting to settle in one's heart and mind where it has not been previously settled, in order to work its destructiveness.

Before we look deeper in the Word of God let us define Watch and Watchful.

Watchful – To take heed (pay attention to listen and consider), be on your guard, be attentive. Be mindful, and observant. Awake, not sleep.

Watch- Stay awake at night. Spiritually during dark times as in grief, depression, distress, weakness, temptations, desires of the flesh i.e. lust and greed. Pay close attention to not let go of the things you have learned and been assured of. Guard your heart.

Vigilant- Be on the alert for danger or error. Circumspect. Keenly watchful to detect trouble. Antonym; Slack, lax, careless, negligent.

Detect- <u>To discover</u>, determine, ascertain and learn the existence, presence or fact of. <u>To discover</u> something subtle or hidden. To discover the unconcealed or the underlying nature.

Watch so that you will know the truth

John 8:31-32 (KJV) 31 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye <u>continue in</u> <u>my word</u>, then are ye my disciples indeed; 32 And ye shall know the truth, and <u>the truth</u> shall make you free. (Jn.17:17)

Matt 26:41 (KJV)

<u>Watch</u> and pray, <u>that you enter not into temptation</u>: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.

Matt 24:42-44 (KJV) 42 <u>Watch</u> therefore: for you know not what hour your Lord doth come. 43 But know this, that if the good man of the house had known in what watch the thief would come, he would have watched, and would not have suffered his house to be broken up. 44 Therefore be ye also <u>ready</u>: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.

Col 4:2 (KJV) Continue in prayer, and watch in the same with thanksgiving;

1 Thess 5:1-7 (NET) 1 Now on the topic of times and seasons, brothers and sisters, you have no need for anything to be written to you. 2 For you know quite well that the day of the Lord will come in the same way as a thief in the night. 3 Now when they are saying, "There is peace and security," then sudden destruction comes on them, like labor pains on a pregnant woman, and they will surely not escape. 4 But you, brothers and sisters, are not in the darkness for the day to overtake you like a thief would. 5 For you all are sons of the light and sons of the day. We are not of the night nor of the darkness. 6 So then we must not sleep as the rest, but must stay alert and sober. 7 For those who sleep, sleep at night and those who get drunk are drunk at night.
