

Follow Me

Matthew 4:19-20

*And he said to them, "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." 20
Immediately they left their nets and followed him.*

There are some 88 references in the four Gospels (ESV) with the word 'follow'.

Definition of "Follow":

1. To go, proceed, or come after
2. To engage in, as a calling or way of life; to pursue
3. To be or act in accordance with; to accept as authority
4. To seek to attain
5. To copy after; imitate
6. To watch steadily, to keep the mind on; to understand the sense or logic of something

 - a. Jesus?

 - b. The Holy Spirit?

4. Did/do you ever find yourself asking Jesus to follow you?
 - a. Is it appropriate to do so?
